Conditions of Participation

1. General Requirements

The participants must be at least 15 years of age and cannot be over 17 years of age at the time of the project.

2. Application, Selection and Participation

Application closes on 16 February 2021. The Goethe-Institut will select two PASCH students to represent Australia in the project commencing on 8 March. By 23 February, the Goethe-Institut contacts the applicants to inform them if they were successful or not.

3. Cancellation

As soon as the participants have officially registered, their participation is binding. They can only cancel their participation with good reason. The cancellation must be made in writing or by e-mail.

4. Costs

Participation in the project Digi-Vision is free of charge.

5. Digital Device

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Participants need a mobile phone with installed and active WhatsApp application, computer, laptop or tablet that is connected to the internet and equipped with a camera, microphone and headphones. The parents/guardians assume full liability for the students during the entire duration of the project. The Goethe-Institut, its employees or persons acting on its behalf cannot be made liable for any damages that may arise in connection with the participation. Instead, the parents/guardians shall bear the costs of such damages. This does not apply to damage resulting from gross negligence or intentional actions of an employee of the Goethe-Institut or person acting on its behalf.
