The online magazine [JÁDU](#) highlights people, their stories, and opinions: in highly personal articles and videos, JÁDU addresses current culturally and socio-politically relevant topics primarily (but not exclusively) from Germany, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, and Ukraine.

As the editor for the Slovak edition of Jádu, your responsibilities include:

- Observing the scene, conducting your own research, and identifying topics relevant to the target audience
- Commissioning external Slovak-speaking journalists to create relevant contributions (articles, interviews, reports, including image editing and acquisition, and, if agreed upon, also audio, video, multimedia formats) in close coordination with the JÁDU editorial team
- Editing and preparing contributions in Slovak for online publication
- Comprehensive and ongoing quality control of the Slovak-language JÁDU edition
- Monitoring deadlines and strictly adhering to agreed deadlines
- Ensuring the quality of translations from German and Ukrainian into Slovak
- Supporting in the communication of content pieces on social media
- Actively participating in relevant online meetings

Requirements:

- Proven qualifications concerning the topics covered by JÁDU
- Experience in preparing editorial/journalistic content
- Experience in multilingual editorial collaboration and relevant language skills (English mandatory, German desirable)
- Experience in social media communication
