# INVITATION TO THE ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION 30 YEARS OF EUROPANETZWERK DEUTSCH

The German Foreign Office and the Goethe-Institut promote the German language as a working and procedural language in the European institutions through the exclusive scholarship programme Europanetzwerk Deutsch. This unique initiative strengthens exchange and networking between representatives of EU institutions, member states, and candidate countries through a variety of language courses and events.

*Brussels, October 23, 2024.* Europanetzwerk Deutsch – the place where a Director General of the European Commission, a senior official from the Portuguese Ministry of the Interior, and a representative from the Serbian Court of Auditors can discuss European economic policy in a German course and, in doing so, gain insights into the perspectives of their European colleagues. Since 1994, the Goethe-Institut has provided participants of Europanetzwerk Deutsch with the opportunity to enhance their German language skills in a professional context while expanding their working contacts at the EU level.

30 years of Europanetzwerk Deutsch means over 3,000 scholarship recipients from 39 countries, more than 15,000 hours of learning German, and more than 1,000 individuals from the European environment connected each year. In weekend and intensive courses, as well as online formats, EU officials and ministerial staff from member states and candidate countries discuss political topics in German. At the same time,
