

Workshop on Documentary Photography and Visual Storytelling

Join us for an inspiring and transformative workshop organized by the Goethe-Institut on behalf of the EUNIC Cluster Bosnia and Herzegovina in collaboration with Foundation "VII Academy" Sarajevo as part of the project ALL INCLUSIVE – Performing Arts for Diversity and Social Inclusion.

This workshop offers a unique opportunity to learn the fundamentals of documentary photography and visual storytelling under the guidance of mentor Marko Drobnjaković, in collaboration with Mitra Simikić. During the workshop, participants will acquire essential skills to tell stories in ways that reflect their own experiences and perspectives.

The focus will be on fundamental techniques of documentary photography, including:

- Elements of Photographic Storytelling
- Using examples from the work of established photographers
- Writing as a tool in documentary practice
- Basics of photo editing and sequencing
- Utilizing mobile phones for documentary photography
- Producing and editing video materials
- Fieldwork (if format and time allow)

This workshop is open to participants of all skill levels and provides an opportunity for creative expression, technical skill development, and a deeper understanding of documentary photography and visual storytelling. Participants will learn to document their experiences and communicate powerful messages through photography and video.
