5 min	Whole group	Children can guess where Wuschel is	 The teacher starts the lesson with a picture of Wuschel and asks the class where Wuschel is. The children see slide 3 and guess for a minute. Then the teacher shows slide 4 and explains that Wuschel is in the supermarket. The teacher tells the children that they are going to listen to the dialogue between Miki and Wuschel in the supermarket. The teacher plays the dialogue for chapter 5 (up to 2:07 min) 	PPT slides 1-4 Wuschel book page 38-40 and audio file chapter 5	 Hallo Kinder - Hello children (Children could answer: Hallo, 'name of club leader') Seid ihr bereit? - Are you ready? 5 min	Whole group	Children can identify new vocabulary (food) and pronounce it	The teacher asks the children what object Miki is buying in the supermarket. (Schokolade) The children see slide 5 and speculate for a minute. Then the teacher removes the grey box and shows the chocolate. The teacher asks the children why Miki is buying chocolate? (It`s object number three!) Now the children see slide 6 and try to match the objects and words with the teacher's assistance. Now the class practises the pronunciation for the objects (slide 7). The teacher reads and points at the objects, while the children repeat after the teacher. 5 min	Small groups	Children can name several foods	The teacher explains that they will play a game called "Was fehlt?" (What's missing?) (slide 8). The teacher assigns the children to small teams. The teams have to name the missing objects. The teacher can uncover the object by removing the grey box. 5 min	Whole group	Children revise the numbers 1-10	The teacher reads the first three sentences on slide 13. The teacher then asks the children if they can remember the subsequent numbers from last	PPT slide 13	Das ist ein Euro. – This is one Euro. Das sind zwei Euro. – That is two Euros. 1=eins 2=zwei

		session. Together they revise the numbers and fill in the blanks. Note It's important here to practise the pronunciation of the words by reading the numbers out loud and asking the children to repeat.		3=drei 4=vier 5=fünf 6=sechs 7=sieben 8=acht 9=neun 10=zehn
10 min In pair	Children play a game and use the new vocabulary	The teacher explains that the children will play another game and test the new vocabulary. The teacher splits the children into teams of 2 and instructs them to play the grocery shopping game. The teacher asks the children to first open their books to page 42 task 2 and choose a few items they want to buy from the list and write them down on their grocery shopping list on page 43. Each team receives then the cut-out image cards from the Grocery shopping game as well as one small brown paper bag. One person plays the seller and the other person the buyer. The teacher explains the game concept by presenting an example with a student using slide 14 . Seller: "Was kaufst du?" (What are you buying?) Buyer: "Ich kaufe (objects)." (I am buying (objects) Seller: "Das kostet (XX Euro)." (This costs XX Euros). Buyer: "XX Euro" Seller: "Danke!" 			The seller will put the corresponding cut out image cards into the brown paper bag and receive the money.		
			Note The teacher can mention a "bonus" challenge and also ask the children to present their teammate's shopping bag e.g. "Linda kauft fünf Bananen, Milch und Schokolade." (Linda is buying 5 bananas, milk and chocolate.)		
4 min	Whole group	Children can ask about someone's favourite food and say what their favourite food is	The teacher explains that the children have learned to ask a few small-talk questions throughout the last four lessons. Today they will learn to ask a new question. They will ask about someone's favourite food (slide 15). The children start a question chain now by throwing a ball and asking for each other's favourite food (slide 16). Optional The teacher can mention a "bonus" challenge and also ask the children to add the questions they have learned within the last weeks: "Wie heißt du?" (What's your name?) Answer: "Ich heiße (name)." (My name is) "Wie alt bist du?" (How old are you?) Answer: "Ich bin (age)." (I am) "Was ist deine Lieblingsfarbe?" (What's your favourite colour?) Answer: "Meine Lieblingsfarbe ist (colour)."
