### November 26 - Music Production Workshop with HERESY

Shaping Sound: Basic Techniques in Music Production (Skill level: Beginner/Intermediate)

Led by local artists **t33g33** and **Joee Mejias**, this workshop focuses on building a strong foundation in music production using **Ableton Live 12 Intro**. From
